- * **Bell Centre “Home of the Montréal Canadiens”** – Enjoy a 45-minute guided tour of this multi-functional amphitheater and host to shows of International renown. Visit will include the press gallery, the Canadiens dressing room (if available), hall of fame and more.
- * **Six Flags La Ronde** – The Park features 41 rides, including 10 tracked roller coasters including *Le Monstre*, which is currently the highest double wooden roller coaster in the world.
