- **Every Bite tells a Story** – Must be hungry to do this tour! Take on a culinary experience in Ottawa! Meet local shopkeepers, chefs and food artisans and taste some of their great food.
- **Parliament Hill** – Visit this historic, neo-Gothic Parliament Buildings stand tall on a hill overlooking the majestic Ottawa River. During the summer months watch guards in scarlet uniforms and bearskin hats as they march with precision to the sound of the accompanying military band.
- **ByWard Market** – Established by Lt-Col. John By in 1826, the ByWard Market is one of Canada's oldest and largest public markets. It features both farm products and artisans' goods, as well as over 600 independent businesses including restaurants, cafes and pubs.
