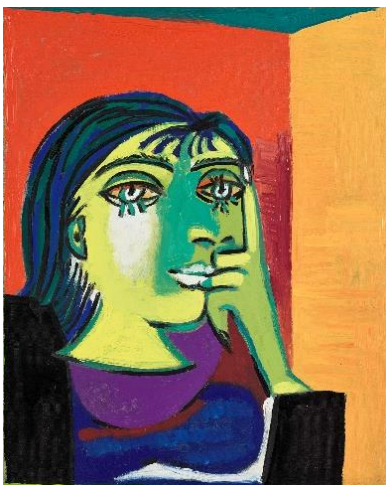


Picasso à Québec
