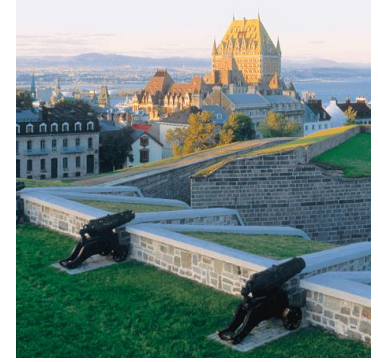




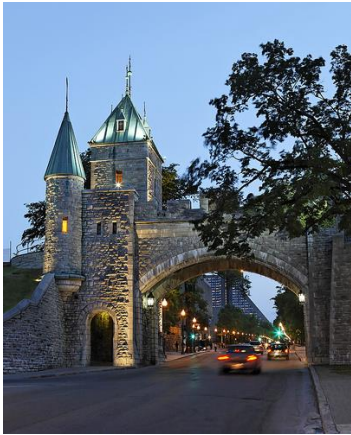

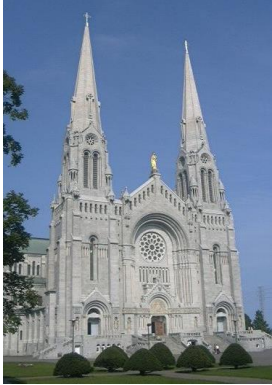

- \* **Village Vacances Valcartier** – This water playground offers various water fun activities, including a Pirates' Hideout, Dungeon City, over 30 waterslides, a lazy river, wave pool, artificial lake, and a game island.
- \* **Rally-Type Scavenger Hunt in Old Québec** – This Introduce Old Quebec history in a different way. This activity leads students to discover Old Quebec, a World Heritage City, by placing them, in small groups, within the context of, and amongst Quebec's historical sites and fortifications.
- \* **Musée de la Civilisation** – Participate in a guided visit of the following permanent exhibition: *People of Quebec... Then and Now! From New France to the present day, trace the history of Québec, both great and small.* This exhibition recounts the political and social history of each of these eras (socioeconomic, cultural and religious trends).
- \* **Shrine of Sainte-Anne de Beaupré** – One of the oldest pilgrimage sites in North America. Although the present basilica was consecrated only 30 years ago, worshippers here have credited the shrine with miraculous cures since it was first built in 1658.
- \* **Traditional Huron Site "ONHOÛA CHETEK8E"** – This is the most authentic recreation of a Québec Indian village. This site offers a unique opportunity to visitors to discover the history, the culture and the lifestyle of Hurons of the past and of today.
