Greater Nashville, Music City!



- **Get a little bit Country!** Enjoy live country music at the legendary Grand Ole Opry. This concert venue has been broadcasting live country music shows every week since 1925. Catch a stage show or enjoy a backstage tour and get insider stories on some famous country stars.
- **Music Row Walking Tour** – It's History, It's Music, It's Recording Studios. Walk in the footsteps of the stars and discover the stories of Music Row's past and present which includes some of the music stars such as Elvis, Dolly, Carrie, Garth, Taylor, Luke and more!
- **Taste the GooGoo Cluster** – Nashville's most iconic treat. Stop by the downtown shop and learn the rich history of Nashville's official candy bar and taste your way through a sample of classic Clusters.
- **General Jackson Showboat** – Hop onboard one of the largest showboats ever build and enjoy a dinner cruise on the Cumberland River enjoying the spectacular skyline of Nashville. From tribute to the King to Tennessee Legends, with guitars, fiddles and voices ringing, this is a must musical treat.
- **Imagine Recording** – Love music? Ever wonder how the hits are made? Live it live! This is an experience where you will be sitting side-by-side with the industry's top session pros as they record new songs at legendary Sound Stage studios on Music Row.
- **Hatch Show Print Tour** – Established in 1879, this is is one of America's oldest working letterpress poster shops. Hatch designs and prints different posters each year for the likes of the Black Keys, Willie Nelson, Miranda Lambert, the Rolling Stones, and others. So, get inky and make your own!
- **Country Music Hall of Fame** – The collection includes more than eight hundred stage costumes, over six hundred instruments, and hundreds of other objects—from microphones to automobiles— Keeping country music history alive!



Greater Memphis



- **Blues, Soul, Rock and Country on Beale Street** – Seven days a week, 365 days a year, this street is filled with the sound of music coming from every open door. Where's the live music? Everywhere.
- **Pay homage to the King** – You've heard the music. Now see the place that Elvis Presley called home: "Graceland". See his mansion, private gardens, aircraft, and more for an unforgettable experience.
- **Sun Studio: The birthplace of Rock N'Roll!** – Grab a milkshake or a soda at the bar and enjoy a guided tour. You'll see where legends old and new recorded some of their most famous tunes -- From Ike Turner, Elvis Presley, B.B. King to U2 and Maroon 5.
- **National Civil Rights Museum at the Lorraine Motel** – The museum galleries are arranged in chronological order telling the story of key episodes for the American Civil Rights Movement from slavery to 1968. With this historic Lorraine Motel façade intact, guest can see room 306 where Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was assassinated in on April 4, 1968.
- **Barbecue, Barbeque, BBQ!** – Spell it however you wish; Memphis celebrates barbecue and here, it's all about the taste. Memphis has over 100+ Barbecue Joint, so you got to try it!
- **Memphis Zoo** – Home to more than 4,500 animals! Get nose-to-nose with polar bears and splashed by sea lions, visit giant pandas in the breathtaking Asian-inspired exhibit. Take in the sights and sounds of at the Teton Trek exhibit, featuring grizzly bears, elk, timber wolves, and some many more!

Everything in between Tennessee's major cities

- **The flight of Jack Daniel's Tour** – Enjoy a behind-the-scenes look at how they make Jack Daniel's, then make a stop at the historic Barrelhouse for a tasting and finally enjoy a home meal at Miss Mary Bobo's Boarding house just like Mr. Jack did a century ago.
- **Bluegrass Underground** – Taped deep within the subterranean amphitheater of The Caverns in Tennessee's majestic Cumberland Mountains, enjoy a "musical adventure" showcasing emerging artists with a broad spectrum of genres including jam band, R&B, Soul & Folk.
- **When the music stopped, the legend began!** – Step aboard the ship-shaped structure for the ultimate Titanic experience.
