- Water Country USA Get ready for a wave of adventure! As the mid-Atlantic's largest water park, Water Country USA offers 43 acres of pools, lazy rivers and water rides. Your student group will have a blast at "Rock 'n' Roll Island," featuring nearly 600 feet of body slides, a 700-foot lazy river and a 9,000-square-foot pool.
- * Campus tour of William & Mary's College Not many colleges can say they've cancelled classes because the British invaded. The College of William & Mary is the second-oldest college in America. The original plans for the College date back to 1618—decades before Harvard—but were derailed by an "Indian uprising." We could not make this stuff up.
- * **Berkeley Plantation** This is the most historic plantation on the James River. Visit the site of the first official Thanksgiving (1619), as well as the birthplace of Benjamin Harrison and President William Henry Harrison, our 9th president.
- * **Treetop Adventure** Get active! Featuring 20+ obstacles and two ziplines, this aerial course uses physical activity to inspire a love for the outdoors.
- Bacon's Castle Hop on a ferry to Surry, VA to visit this 17th century mansion, also known as "Allen's Brick House". The House earned the moniker "Bacon's Castle" in 1676 when several of Nathaniel Bacon's men occupied the home for four months during the uprising that became known as Bacon's Rebellion.
- * Monticello: Home of Thomas Jefferson Learn about the people who lived and worked at the plantation over 200 years ago. Get to know Thomas Jefferson, author of the Declaration of Independence and Statute of Virginia for Religious Freedom, third president of the United States, and founder of the University of Virginia.
